






## **Overview Report**

Since inception, SAR has kept to its promise to use school aligned units of study, comprehensive teacher training, universal whistle commands, positive language, and standardized equipment to facilitate an introduction to the lifetime sport of target shooting to school-aged youth in grades 4 through 12.

#### **Accomplishments**

- Reached over 18,000 students with SAR lessons since 2014.
- Celebrated 5 years of incorporation in March 2021.
- Launched a new Strategic Plan in 2022.
- Trained over 475 individuals, primarily teachers, as Basic Air Riflery Instructors.



#### **Upcoming Projects**

- Partnering with Texas Parks & Wildlife Department to produce videos of the BARI training so parts of the training will be completed online.
- In the process of trademarking "Shoot for Success" and adding additional content to the curriculum. Students will learn even more skills to help them be successful in life while using an air rifle as the teaching tool.
- Scheduled to debut an updated BARI guide in 2023 as well as a pocket guide.
- Working on applying for a Multi-state grant for possible SAR student research.
- Continuing to implement and update the SAR Strategic Plan.
